FLOWER	LOOKS LIKE	BENEFITS	BEST PLANTED WITH
MARIGOLDS (Tagetes)		• Repel nematodes, aphids, and whiteflies • Attract beneficial insects	Tomatoes, peppers, eggplant, cucumbers, cabbage, beans
NASTURTIUMS (Tropaeolum)		• Attract aphids away from vegetables • Flowers and leaves are edible!	Cabbage, broccoli, cucumbers, squash, beans
CALENDULA (Pot Marigold)		• Attracts hoverflies and ladybugs • May help deter nematodes	Tomatoes, peppers, beans, carrots, lettuce
BORAGE (Borago officinalis)		• Attracts pollinators like bees • Improves flavor and growth of plants	Tomatoes, strawberries, squash, cucumbers
SWEET ALYSSUM (Lobularia maritima)		• Attracts beneficial insects • Helps control aphids	Cabbage, broccoli, lettuce, peppers
ZINNIAS (Zinnia elegans)		• Attracts pollinators like butterflies and bees • Brightens the garden!	Tomatoes, beans, cucumbers, squash
COSMOS (Cosmos bipinnatus)		• Attracts beneficial insects • Helps improve pollination in the garden	Tomatoes, cucumbers, carrots, peppers
SUNFLOWERS (Helianthus annuus)		• Attracts pollinators • Provides shade • Helps support climbing plants	Beans, cucumbers, squash, corn
